

















The purpose of these tricky lyrics is to correct often mis-spoken and mis-sung consonants.

"Tr" should not sound like "Chr". "Tuh-rick" is the correct consonant sound for "trick." "Dr" should not sound like "J". (Duh-rop) is the correct consonant sound for "drop."

"Ch"ildren and "Tr"ain opening consonants should be different ("Tuh-rain" instead of incorrect "Chrain.") "Ch" uses lips, "Tr" uses only the tongue.

"Dr" uses a forward tongue position to begin the sound and no lip tension.

"Dr" is often mispronounced, substituted with a "J" sound. ("Duh-rive" instead of incorrect "Juh-rive")

Appropriate "Ch" and "J" words are included to create an awareness on how they differ from often mispronounced "Tr" and "Dr". (Children, Just, Jolly, Choc'late)

Words that require special focus: Trick, Treat, Train, Track, Trust, Trouble, Drop, Truffle, Drive. (Additional focus: bring tongue all the way forward to begin all "Th" sounds: The, Them, Their)
